The Genetic Information Nondiscrimination Act of 2008 (“GINA”) is designed to prohibit the use of genetic information in health insurance and employment. GINA makes it unlawful for employers to discriminate against an employee because of that person’s genetic information. It also places restrictions on employers’ ability to acquire or disclose employees’ genetic information and requires employers to treat any genetic information they may obtain as confidential medical records. This seminar will aid employers in clarifying GINA’s restrictions as well as navigating through particular situations that could otherwise present pitfalls for unsuspecting employers.
